Emphasis is a principle that artists use to control what you first notice about a work. It can be achieved in several ways.

One way is dominance, making one element the \_\_\_\_\_\_ or most important thing in work. The dominant element might be a certain kind of brushstroke, color, or shape.

A second method is to set up a \_\_\_\_\_ point or center of interest:

- This may be done by isolating an important element from the space around it.
- The most important element might be larger than others or be placed near the center of a work.
