corporations, and provoked a closer look at the country's financial affairs in general. Nevertheless, Ronald Reagan completed two terms - as the 1980s came to a close, his Vice President George Bush was elected President.

Entering the postindustrial era, the job market was changing - traditional

jobs were diminishing in number. Working factory jobs had been satisfactory for supporting a family, but not so in the 1990s. Even though many Americans was experiencing prosperity, those who relied on such jobs were left out. New technologies flourished; computers started appearing in workplaces and in homes. Computers appeared where they hadn't been seen before - in medicine, in video games, movies, and banking.



Women also came into view in more workplaces while they continued to manage their homes and families; they were know as "supermoms."
